First Potato Show 100 Years Ago

Excerpt from Weston Leader Newspaper, Nov. 3, 1922

"The first Umatilla County Potato Show, held Saturday at Weston in Memorial Hall has passed into history. It was the first event of the sort ever staged in the county, but opinions are general that it will not be the last. The success of the show surpassed the expectations of its sponsors. It brought a large throng of people, especially in the afternoon, and the exhibits were comprehensive, attractive, and highly creditable, in view of the fact this was King Spud's initial public appearance in the Blue Mountain Empire."
