September 2023 marks the 36th anniversary of National Library Card Sign-Up Month, a time when local libraries all over the country remind parents that a library card is the most important school supply of all. Library cards are free at our library to folks in the 97886 zip code service area.

With your library card, you can access everything in our collection, as well as from 74 other libraries across Eastern Oregon. You can walk into any of those libraries and check out items, or we can request that they be brought via courier to Weston. A library card also lets you check out e-books and audiobooks using the free Libby platform. Homework help is also available in

the form of the Gale databases, linked to our website.

To get a card, just bring in some sort of ID, proof of residence, and for minors, the signature of a guardian. All new library cards issued at our library in September come with a free book bag. There's nothing more empowering than a library card, for people of all ages. So what are you waiting for? Come get yours!
